

Hermit crabs live in tide pools. They come in many colors and patterns. Most hermit crabs are nocturnal and come out at night to look for food.





This hermit crab was given a clear shell to crawl into so you can see how the shell protect its soft abdomen.

Hermit crabs don't make their own shell. They find empty shells to live in. The abdomen that fits in the shell is very soft. The front of the body is hard.




Hermit crabs are omnivores. They eat both plants and animals. They eat up bits of dead sea animals they find in tide pools. They keep our tide pools clean!

As a hermit crab grows the shell it is living in becomes too tight, so it looks for a bigger shell to move into. Sometimes two hermit crabs fight over a shell they both want.

This hermit crab is moving into a bigger shell.









Hermit crabs need our help! People love to collect shells so hermit crabs often can't find shells to move into as they grow. Sometimes they have to move into things that are not safe for them or can't find a shell in time. You can help by leaving shells in tide pools.




